The floor was open for public comment at 7:01 p.m. and immediately closed with no residents present.

Road Report:

Rolled the Northeast Bradford School baseball and softball fields.

Took chains and plows off.

Swept all tar and chipped roads

Graded and rolled material on Deehan and Wolf Hill Rd.

Added pipe headwalls and cleaned up ditches on Dehaan Rd.

Repaired and installed numerous road signs

Pushed cinders into shed and put rake on the tractor

Changed fluids, filters, and repaired the roller hydraulic hose in the roller

Turned in the dirt and gravel rd. applications.

Had a successful township cleanup day

All bills on hand were paid.

The Herrick Volunteer Fire Company contract was signed.

Liquid Fuel and State Road Turnback funds came in for \$170,920.73.

After reviewing information, Chad Cooley made a motion to purchase the MG 6-10 Drag-A-Box Asphalt Material Spreader for \$28,550.00. Jeff Robbins seconded this motion, John Strobe made it unanimous, and the motion passed.

Pending the updated oil pricing, Chad Cooley made a motion to advertise the extra dust oil opportunity for township residents. John Strobe seconded that motion, Jeff Robbins made it unanimous and the motion passed.

Bidding for AEP/EDP dust control will also be advertised with bid packets due by the next meeting on May 21st.

Jeff Robbins made a motion to go ahead with advertising the position of tax collector that will be open in January 2026. Chad Cooley seconded that motion and the motion passed.

Claire Road is still pending at this time.
